## Steering Committee

### PHASE I: Strategic Organizing

1. Select steering committee
  2. Develop leadership structure
  3. Identify key aging issues
  4. Highlight community aging issues
  5. Develop mission statement
  6. Identify key stakeholders of Stakeholders Committee and invite them to join
- \*Partners/n4a will help guide first meeting via conference call.

**TIMELINE: 2 months**

## Stakeholders Committee

### PHASE II: Expanding the Circle

1. Engage a stakeholders group
  2. Design a community action plan
- \*Staff member of Partners or n4a will be at each community's first meeting with the stakeholders group to make a general presentation on Aging in Place, facilitate discussion on the community action plan and ensure all questions are answered.

**TIMELINE: 7-9 months**

## Community Demonstration

### Community Project

1. Mobilize the public by direct action
- \* Both Partners and n4a representatives will visit each community to assist in the design, development and implementation of community project.

### PHASE III: Defining a Multiple-year Game Plan

1. Outline a long-term aging agenda for the community.
- \* Both Partners and n4a will provide guidance on plan development.
